



Homeland Security Infrastructure Program (HSIP) Gold and Freedom



The **HSIP Gold** database is assembled by the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) in partnership with the Homeland Infrastructure Foundation-Level Data (HIFLD) Working Group for use by Homeland Defense (HD), Homeland Security (HLS), National Preparedness – Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response and Recovery (NP-PPMR&R) communities. It is a compilation of 560 of the best available, geospatially enabled baseline infrastructure datasets for all National & Defense Critical Infrastructure Sectors. HSIP Gold data is assembled from federal, state, local government and private sector mission partners. **HSIP Freedom**, led by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), is a license free subset of HSIP Gold. These datasets assist HD, HLS, and NP-PPMR&R mission partners with planning, situational awareness, threat and impact analysis (natural or man-made), modeling emergencies, protection of borders, and decision making during response and recovery operations.

Availability and Distribution

HSIP Gold can be disseminated to all federal government members (including validated supporting contractors and consultants), National Guard Forces (WMD-CSTs, CIPMAA Teams and Joint Force Headquarters (JFHQ) – State) and to States with approved Presidential Disaster or Emergency Declarations to support the HD, HLS and NP – PPMR&R missions. Non-federal mission partners are also authorized to view HSIP Gold when served from a federal government-owned, secure application or service. HSIP Freedom is available to federal, state, local, and tribal government, industry partners, and their supporting contractors to supporting HD, HLS and NP-PPMR&R missions. HSIP Freedom is a

compilation of 356 of the HSIP Gold layers available for download through the DHS Geospatial Information Infrastructure (GII), hosted on the Homeland Security Information Network (HSIN) Geospatial Resources Community (GRC).
