Local Agency GIS Survey 2006

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Homeland Security

The San Diego Local Agency GIS Survey was conducted in the Fall of 2006 for the San Diego Regional GIS Council (SDRGC). The Council serves as a forum for San Diego region public agencies to develop partnerships, and share information, ideas, strategies, and solutions regarding the management of GIS and related technologies. The Council meets quarterly with the goal of providing more efficient and effective service to member agencies and their constituents.

For the survey, each agencies GIS manager was asked to fill out an on-line survey that asked questions regarding their agency's Geographic Information System (GIS), staff and budgeting, functions and applications, internet and intranet mapping, the data each agency maintains, computer aided dispatch systems, and coordination and collaboration.

The purpose of this survey is to provide an understanding of GIS in the region. Past surveys were conducted in 1995, 1997, and 2001. The surveys have helped to identify the capabilities and knowledge available at each agency, create an understanding of the nature of digital data maintained by public agencies in the region, and provide information about digital data sources. In addition, the consecutive nature of the surveys offers information on how the use of GIS in the region has grown and transformed over the years.

A secondary purpose of this survey is to build a regional GIS baseline for homeland security. The baseline will help to focus the GIS needs for homeland security and guide decisions for the region.

The survey has changed and expanded over the years to accommodate the ever changing and expanding technologies associated with GIS. Thirty-four agencies provided information for this survey. Only two agencies responded that they were not current users of GIS, these agencies were asked to only provide information about implementing a GIS and no other questions. Two other agencies only provided contact information. Agencies were not required to answer every question so the response counts for each question may be different. Appendices have been attached that summarizes some of the questions with categorized list or tables that provide information on the following:

- GIS Software used
- Databases used in conjunction with GIS
- Operating systems used in conjunction with GIS
- Programming languages used in conjunction with GIS
- GIS application implemented by agency
- Internet and intranet mapping applications
- Coordinate systems
- GIS layers maintained by agency
- Geospatial assistance for emergency management operations
- Contact information for programmers and departments

In summary, the San Diego region has a very mature GIS community. Fifty-three percent of the respondents have been using GIS for more than 10 years and another seventeen percent have between 5 and 9 years of experience. Every agency responding to the survey uses ArcGIS Desktop software. Most agencies rely on one or more geospatial layers maintained or warehoused by SanGIS, but those agencies also maintain many other geospatial layers and associated tables. Agencies provide data and GIS capabilities to several departments and many have built internet and intranet applications to disseminate the information. There are a number of programming languages employed by each agency in conjunctions with their GIS, most use at least three different languages with some using seven or more. Metadata and meeting the Federal Geographic Data Committee (FGDC) minimum standards are the weakest link in our GIS community with only a little over half the agencies maintaining metadata on their layers and only half of those meet the minimum FGDC standards. Lastly, there was not a large consensus in the region on what priorities would benefit GIS most if Homeland Security monies became available. The data for this question is reported by the percentage of responding agencies that ranked each priority in their top five. The five priorities that most consistently ranked the highest are: improve maintenance (data updates), hire staff, build additional layers, design system architecture for enterprise GIS, and tied for fifth are implement applications and increase accuracy.
